- We strongly advise that you visit the UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) website for the most up-to-date visa rules before you make a visa application.
- To check whether you need a visa to study in the UK, please visit the UKVI website and complete the online questionnaire.
- If you are from outside the EEA/EU and you plan to stay in the UK to study you need to check your visa status & eligibility. To find out whether you are eligible for a student visit visa email admin@ukversity.co.uk

CREDIBILITY INTERVIEWS

- The Home Office has introduced credibility interviews as part of the short term visitor visa application process.
- Some students may be interviewed when submitting their application. Please prepare for these interviews in advance, so that you're confident answering questions about your plans to study in the UK.
- To help you with this, we've prepared a list of possible questions you may be asked during the interview and we recommend you practice answering questions of this type.
- Ask admission team for these questions.

- Why do you want to study in the UK?
- What are the benefits of studying in the UK compared to your home country or USA/Canada/Australia etc.?

QUESTIONS ABOUT LIVING AS A STUDENT IN

TOEFL RESTRICTIONS ENFORCED BY UKVI

TOEFL was removed from the list of Secure English Language Tests (SELT) approved by UK Visa & Immigration.

Only IELTS & Trinity english are acceptable for Tier 4 visa's.

FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS ACCEPTED/ NOT ACCEPTED BY UKVI

- •UKVI has produced a list of financial institutions which will not be accepted for verifying students maintenance funds, when students apply for short term visitor visa (6 or 11 months) or Tier 4 General visa to come to the UK.
- An applicant will receive no points for maintenance if they submit documents showing that the funds are held in a financial institution on the list of non-acceptable banks.
- To assist applicants, UKVI have also provided lists of financial institutions in each country from which financial statements are accepted.

NEW TIME LIMITS FOR STUDYING IN THE UK

You are not allowed to exceed the maximum time limit spent in the UK on a student visitor visa (6 or 11 months) or Tier 4 visa. It is your responsibility to plan your studies in the UK according to these rules. If you're not sure whether your chosen course will take you over this limit check the UKCISA website and check with admis-

- We strongly recommend that you take out insurance for your own financial and personal security.

 - personal liability
 - legal expenses
